Rush Union is excited to announce major renovations will be coming to the Milton Indoor facility. A complete remodel of the indoor field will be taking place in the next few months. The renovation will include replacement of the turf, lighting, repair of the ceiling, and walls. Also, during the renovation, new doors and locks will be installed at the facility. While we are still working with our general contractor, we anticipate the project will begin after Tryouts and we hope to have the project completed before the beginning of the Fall 2023 Season. During this time, we will also be assessing and making other needed repairs to the facility.

In addition to the Indoor field remodel, we have successfully negotiated an extension of our lease for the Milton facility. We are really excited about the long-term future of the facility and the programming possibilities this brings to our community for both youths and adults.

Further, we have partnered with The Collective Global, a consulting firm, that will lead us through a strategic planning process. The Collective Global has a history of working with soccer clubs, like Rush Union, and we are eager to gain their knowledge to help us better serve our membership.

Boris "Boki" Fridman update:

It has been a very hard time for the Rush Union family as our friend and coach, Boris "Boki" Fridman, was laid to rest. We appreciate the support shown to his family by the Membership, Coaches, and Administration. Rush Union would like to continue to support the family and honor Coach Boki. As such, we are planning a couple of things-

First, we would like to start a 529 Savings Plan to benefit his daughter, Evelyn, who is 1 ½ years old. We are currently discussing the setup of the account and how to accept donations to the account with our accountants. We will provide more information on the account once it is set up.

We are also planning to create the Boris "Boki" Fridman Legacy Award which would include a scholarship for the selected player. The award will be presented to the player who embodies the Rush Core Values which are something Coach Boki tried to teach all his players. The scholarship will be funded through donations, an annual Coaches game, and other club events.

Finally, Coach Boki will be honored at The Father Christmas Cup. The tentative date for the event is December 9, 2023. The Father Christmas Cup is an annual charity soccer tournament raising money for local families who have recently lost a parent.
